


The POENB 2023 Membership Survey was designed as an opportunity to learn from our Members, in order to take positive action on the areas that matter to them.

How long have you been a POENB Member?




What Type of POENB Membership do you have?



During the Summer Season (May to September), does your household utilize POENB's Price's Bend or Valley Grove Beaches?




Which POENB Beach do you frequent most often?





What Members are saying about the watercraft storage system? (Continued...)

The overall system is okay, but there is too much uncertainty for members who have more than one watercraft. It shouldn't be up in the air every other year to store a second kayak or paddleboard. If space is truly that tight then more storage accommodations are needed, whether those are additional racks or beach areas designated for watercraft. There does not appear to be any enforcement of the watercraft removal policy. Enforcement would create an incentive for those storing watercraft on POENB property--but not using the watercraft--to remove it and free up space.






Which POENB events did your household attend in 2022?






Are you looking to see an increase in POENB's social events in 2023?




What is the most you are willing to spend to attend a POENB event with live entertainment (e.g. Endless Summer 70's Concert)?




What is the most you are willing to spend to attend a POENB event without live entertainment (e.g. Parti Gras)? (Multiple responses per person accepted*)





It seems unusual that in 2023 a private beach still does not accommodate new mothers and/or fathers and young families with proper bathroom facilities to include a shower and changing room. We need to secure our access routes -Bevin road - this survey includes john Ballow as well Would be happy to participate in additional water quality initiatives The beach fencing at Prices Bend Needs much attention...this issue should be up for Debate by all members of POEMB and this community. A decision should not be made by just a few members of the POEMB board. The dilapidated split rail fence has a negative effect on our community, especially one that is valued as a "Beach Community". If the board feels we can not afford it now, than we should consider replacing New, a few sections at a time, each year.

This New fence will not only enhance the beach area but will also clearly identify beach boundaries.

I support POENB as a most valuable community group which protects our beaches and provides many social activities for its membership.
